A-Zone in Pittsford, 789 Linden Avenue, **Second Tuesday** of each month

B-Zone in Henrietta, 245 Summit Point Drive, **First Tuesday** of each month

C-Zone in Chili, 4201 Buffalo Road, **Third Tuesday** of each month

Tuesdays – 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

- Please place unused prescription and over-the-counter medications in a plastic bag; and place needles in a separate bag for safety of handlers
- Be sure the name of the medication is on the bottle (you may black out any personal information)
- All medicines are destroyed by an incineration process overseen by law enforcement
- Drop-off is free and open to the public
